## Curriculum Outline

The curriculum is designed to provide students with a structured progression through core disciplines, fostering both theoretical understanding and applied competence across key areas of study.

The core disciplines included in this programme are:

Modules	Module Purpose
Principles of Interaction Design	The purpose of this module is to explore cognitive and psychological considerations of interaction design, principles of usability and the ethical and legal concerns related to accessible design. This module enables students to define guidelines for user-friendly interfaces and critically evaluate their impact on User Experience.
User Experience Design	Students will be introduced to the fundamental building blocks of user experience design and will apply user centred design processes while exploring UX design methods and tools to inform meaningful User Experience design outcomes.
User Experience and Technology	This module examines the dynamics between technology and User Experience and provides students with the contextual background to evaluate and explore the possibilities and appropriate use of various technologies to design meaningful User Experiences for South African, African, and global contexts.
User Experience Research Methodology	This module will play an important part in developing students' abilities to gather, analyse, interpret, and evaluate data to inform strategic User Experience design outcomes. Students will engage with the processes, methods, and tools of UX research for a deeper understanding of appropriate research processes and techniques.
User Experience Project Management	The module will unpack the various project-management approaches and develop students' abilities to identify and select multi-disciplinary teams and manage UX design projects. Learn how to engage with project-management aspects such as preparing and presenting project proposals, defining project-scopes and milestones and costing projects.
User Experience Design Project	Students will learn how to practically apply the knowledge, principles and skills gained from the completed modules to design and present a cohesive and consistent User Experience Design solution supported by sound interaction- and user centred design principles, accompanied by a smart project plan.

## System and Software Requirements

Exams are written at an exam centre and in some instances online. These details will be specified in your Programme Assessment Schedule (PAS).

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## Graduation and Completion Requirements for This Qualification

In order to be awarded this qualification, you must have achieved a minimum final year mark of fifty percent (50%) for all 6 modules in the curriculum.

As a distance (online) student, this qualification is structured to be completed over 1.5 years. The maximum time for completing a qualification full-time is double the minimum time associated with the qualification, and for part-time an additional year is allowed.

## Where Assessments Are Written in Person

- For students based in South Africa, online students may select any Emeris campus as their Examination Centre.
- An alternative examination centre is only permissible for students studying abroad and those located in a province of South Africa where there is no IIE campus. If there is no IIE campus within reach, an alternative venue will need to be sourced by you. For non-IIE venues, there is an alternative venue levy per module.
