Our SDG Journey and Selection of Sustainable Development Goals

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as the Global Goals, address the world's most critical challenges including poverty, inequality, climate change, environmental degradation, peace and justice. Whilst some of these goals may appear to be idealistic, they are all interconnected, and it is the combined focus and commitment of many entities and individuals that contribute practically to the achievement of a more equitable and sustainable world.

A core directive of our strategy is to be mindful of what we are, as an educational institution, and what we want to be known for. Our business imperative is to do education well and with purpose. Whilst Goal #4 (Quality Education) is our core focus and what we are renowned for, a conscious decision was made by Emeris to embed other critical and relevant goals into our SDG strategy and our organisational DNA. Our inclusive education develops empathetic and versatile young individuals who will create respectful working relationships and meaningful economic growth.



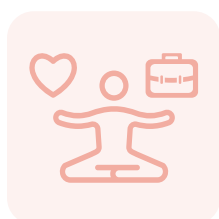
Environment

Our strategic imperative to educate our students, staff and broader communities enables self-advancement and equitable employment opportunities for impactful growth.

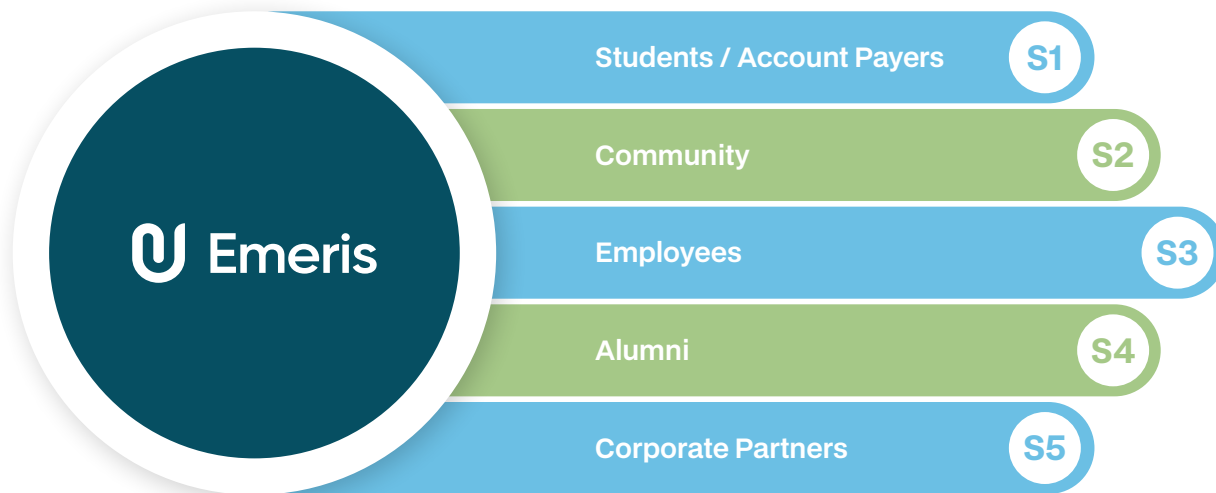


Wellness

Our authentic commitment to nurturing the wellness of our staff, students and broader community gives rise to a healthier, more hopeful and sustainable future for all.

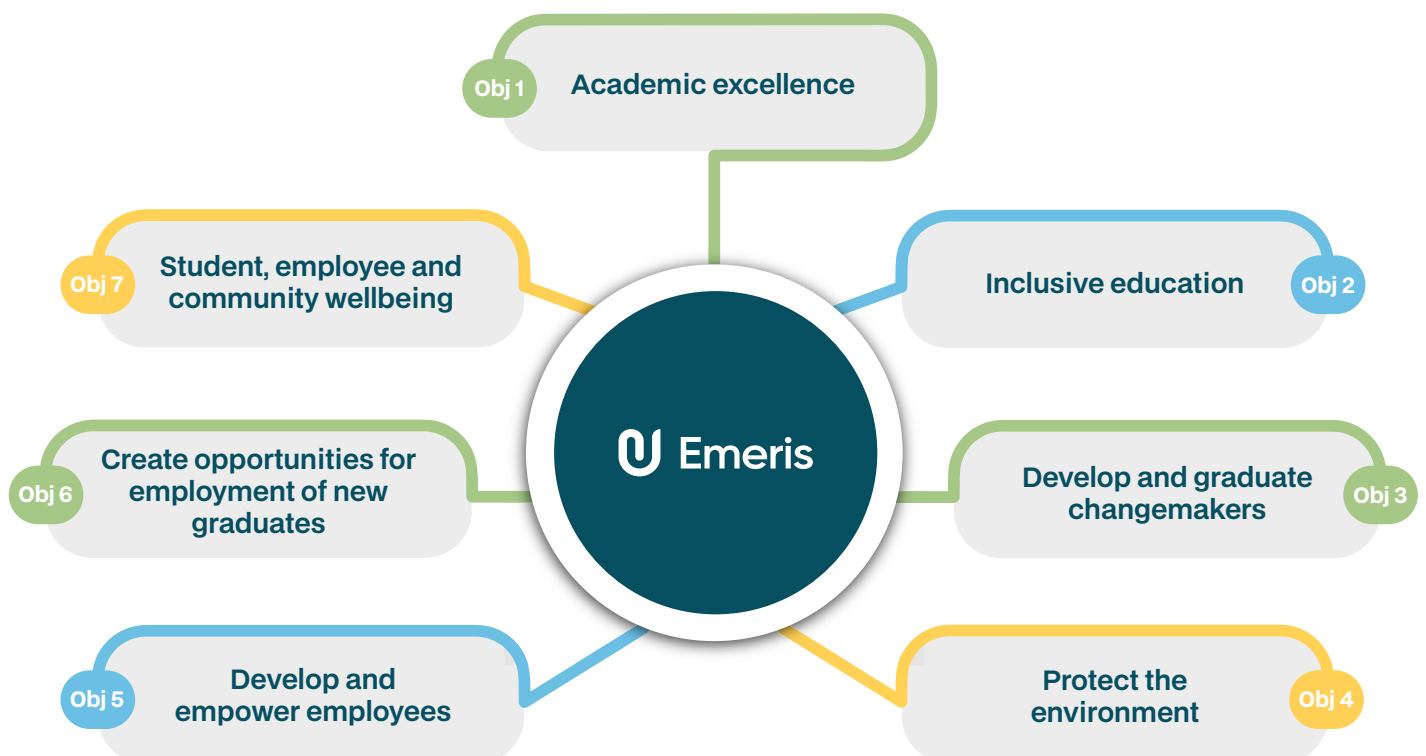

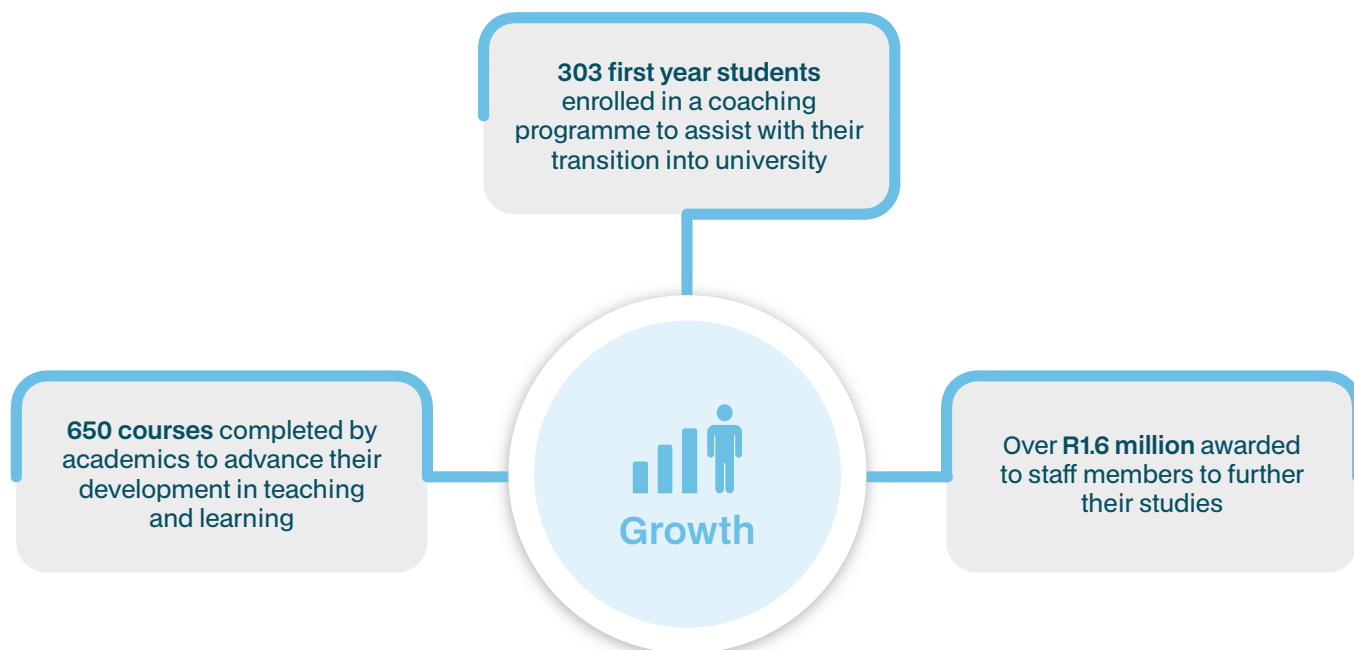
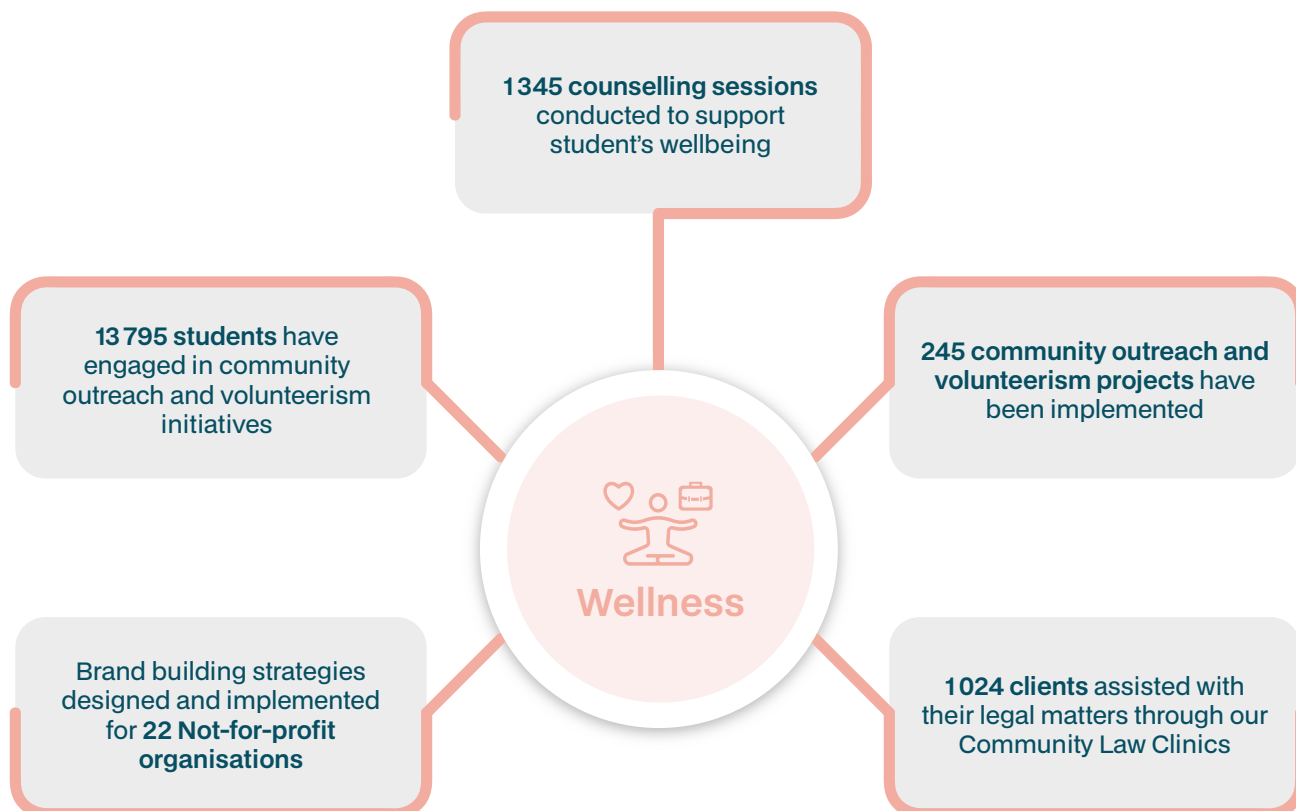
Our Objectives
